MINUTES CABINET MEETING NOVEMBER 17TH 2013 WINSLOE LIONS CLUB

District Governor Lucio called the meeting to order at 11:10am with the singing of O Canada. Lions invocation was led by 1st VDG Susan. We observed a moment of silence for deceased members and World Peace.

The agenda was approved with item #14 amended to read LFC instead of LCIF.

Roll call was taken with 28 clubs present and 73 members attending.
