

District N-1 Cabinet Meeting Minutes February 23rd 2014 Riverview Lion Club New Brunswick

District Governor Lucio called the meeting to order at 11:07am with the singing of O Canada led by Lion Dale Carter

Lion Arline Hachey led us in the Lions Invocation. DG Lucio's interrupter for the Cabinet Meeting was Lion Maurice Dallaire from HUM Lew Sun. A moment of silence was observed for deceased members and World Peace.

Call for approval of the Agenda, moved by PDG Tim Hoban seconded by PDG Gerard Hartigan Lion James Belliveau, President of Riverview Lions Club welcomed the Lions to the Lions Club. DG Luciio introduced the Head Table

Roll Call was taken by CST Stewart MacDonald with 63 Lions representing 23 clubs, including 5 Presidents and 10 Secretaries.

Cabinet officers introduced themselves 24 Officers and Zone Chairs present.

Past District Governors introduced themselves with 5 in attendance.

DG Lucio gave his report speaking of lost clubs and new members added to our District. He spoke of the Family and friends project in April and the Join the World 24 hour Lunch Relay on April 4th 2014 DG Lucio spoke on our work in Lionism over the years and suggested we ask our hearts why we became involved in Lions and we should pass on our understanding to new Lions and thanked all Lions on a job well done.

DG Lucio spoke about clubs being cancelled but one may be brought back in. He wants to encourage new clubs and help those who are in trouble.

VDG (1st) Susan Sangster spoke on her experience at the incoming DG training. VDG Susan addressed the loss of the two clubs that have been cancelled. She also spoke on the importance of clubs completing their PU 101 on line at MyLCI and the upcoming club elections. Another topic was the upcoming International Convention in Toronto and what a great opportunity for the Lions of our area to participate as it will be so close. The chances of the International Convention coming to our area again in the near future is very slim. VDG Susan spoke on the lunch relay as well sharing that it will begin in Australia and continues with the time zones around the worls.

She thanked all clubs that participated in APSEA donations and reminded the clubs it is now time to forward their funds to the CST payable to Lions Clubs International District N-1.

VDG Doug spoke of the Multiple District Convention in Corner Brook Newfoundland. He touched on the Regional Lions leadership Training in Nova Scotia, the International Convention and the upcoming USA Canada Forum in Puerto Rico in September.

2nd VDG Doug thanked all Lion Secretaries for sending reports monthly and sharing what Lions are doing in their clubs. He reported on the success of the Milledgeville North End Lions club as they were about to close, sell their building when the community said they were needed and they brought in 7 new members with more to follow. He suggested it as a challenge to smaller clubs to reach out to the community to get more members.

CST Stewart asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the November Cabinet Meeting in Winsloe as circulated, PDG Gerard moved, PSCT Harold seconded, motion carried.

CST Stewart asked for a motion to approve the Financial Report as at February 20th moved by PDG Gerard seconded by Lion Paul Matheson.

Questions by Lion Paul Gauthier on the Cavalcade pins for PEI, they are given away and in NB they are charged for. PCC Rod asked for adjustments in the numbers for the second half of the year. Motion Carried.

CST Stewart advised the Lions that our LCI Insurance Policy should be given to all Insurance Agents for those clubs that have buildings to make sure they are not paying for items they are already cover in. On club saved several hundreds of dollars by doing so. He also spoke of clubs getting their dues paid.

Meeting was called back to order at 12:50. Lion Brennan introduced our guest speaker Pas Marcantonio an optometrist from Riverview who spoke of his work in establishing an eye clinic in the Philippines. The presentation was informative and enlightening. A slide presentation was also included. Dr Marcantonio's work in the Philippines is volunteer, much of the equipment has been donated and the Lions have donated many used glasses to assist in the project.

PDG Gerard completed the audit report from 2012-2013 and requested the adoption of the report as presented, seconded by Lion Paul. Motion Carried.
